

# RED GUIDE POST SYSTEM

Due to the increasing spread of some Noxious weed species, mainly grass species and in particular SPINY BURR GRASS, Council has placed red guide posts in areas where these plants have been found.



Because Spiny Burr Grass is not easily distinguishable from other grass species until they have set seed it is very hard to control and is readily spread by vehicle tyres, stock, feral and native animals.

The guide posts have been placed on both sides of the road at the beginning and end of the infestations and it is requested that Council staff and the public **do not slash, grade or drive on the road shoulders through these areas** until the area has been inspected and appropriately treated.
