

By entering the Central West Livestock Exchange you agree to comply with Public Health Order directions and Council's Conditions of Entry while on the premises. These conditions have been put in place to protect the health and welfare of members of the public during the Covid-19 pandemic, and align with the Central West Livestock Exchange Safety Plan.

Physical Distancing

- 1 Observers are not permitted to enter the Facility.
- 2 Livestock carriers must leave the site immediately on conclusion of unloading.
- 3 Out loading carriers are to remain in their vehicle until loading is commenced, and are not permitted to attend the sale.
- 4 Ensure the maximum safe capacity of 40 people is not exceeded in the CWLE Canteen (based on 1 person per 4m²).
- 5 Ensure activities are as non-contact as possible.
- 6 Ensure a distance of 1.5m is maintained between individuals.
- 7 Ensure you arrive and leave as close as possible to when you need to be here.

Handwashing and Hygiene

- 1 Practice good hygiene by following NSW Health posters displayed within the Facility, including hand washing with soap and water or sanitizer, and covering coughs and sneezes with a tissue or by coughing into your elbow.

Cleaning

- 1 Users of the CWLE canteen will use the provided hand sanitizer on entry to the canteen, and will utilise the provided disinfectant sprays and wipes to clean tables and chairs within the canteen after their use. Council cleans the facility each evening.

General

- 1 In accordance with Public Health (Covid-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 4) 2020, supply contact details for contact tracing purposes, noting this record will be supplied to NSW Health, on request by the Chief Medical Officer. All attendees at the CWLE must present a completed *Central West Livestock Exchange Attendance Register* form on their arrival, each day they attend the Facility.
- 2 You must not access the Central West Livestock Exchange if:
 - a) You have a sore throat, cough and/or flu-like symptoms; or
 - b) You been in contact with someone diagnosed as having Covid-19, and in which case you must not attend the Facility for 14 days.
- 3 Contact Forbes Shire Council immediately if any of your party is diagnosed with Covid-19 and has attended the Central West Livestock Exchange within the last 14 days of being diagnosed.
- 4 Forbes Shire Council reserves the right to alter the conditions of entry, or revoke access to the Central West Livestock Exchange, without notice, in the event of amendments to Public Health Orders, or a local outbreak of Covid-19 within the Forbes community.
