

Conditions of Entry – Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area

By entering the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area you agree to comply with Public Health Order directions and Council's Conditions of Entry while on the premises. These conditions have been put in place to protect the health and welfare of members of the public during the Covid-19 pandemic, and align with the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area Safety Plan.

Physical Distancing

- 1 Ensure a distance of 1.5m is maintained between individuals.

Handwashing and Hygiene

- 1 Practice good hygiene by following NSW Health posters displayed within the Rest Area, including hand washing with soap and water or sanitizer, and covering coughs and sneezes with a tissue or by coughing into your elbow.

Cleaning

- 1 High-touch areas of the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area are to be cleaned by the users during their stay.

General

- 1 Supply contact details to Council's Rangers, for contact tracing purposes, noting this record will be supplied to NSW Health on request by the Chief Medical Officer.
- 2 You must not access the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area if:
 - a) You have a sore throat, cough and/or flu-like symptoms; or
 - b) You been in contact with someone diagnosed as having Covid-19, and in which case you must not attend the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area for 14 days.
- 3 Contact Forbes Shire Council immediately if any of your party is diagnosed with Covid-19 and has attended the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area within the last 14 days of being diagnosed.
- 4 Ensure you adhere to the general conditions of use for the Wheego Short-Stay Rest Area, as indicated by the signage located within the Rest Area.
